#### MIDDLE SCHOOL TABLE LEADERS NEEDED

In total, there will be 13 classes, 1 confession night, and 7 Masses to attend. #### Thank You for Your Generosity

In a time of urgent need, our parish family once again demonstrated the love of Christ through your extraordinary generosity.

Thanks to your support, we were able to collect \$4,381 in last weekend's second collection for the Texas flood victims. In addition, through prayerful discernment and stewardship, our parish was able to donate an additional \$10,000 from our poor box collections to support families affected by the devastation.

Each week, your offerings to the poor box-typically between \$200 and \$300-are quietly set aside to help those in greatest need, right here in our local community. These funds are used with great care, prayer, and discernment to offer timely help in times of crisis. The decision to extend support to Texas came from that same spirit of compassion and mission. We are also blessed to share that another \$10,000 has been donated to our local Good Samaritan Food Bank in Raceland, helping to fight food insecurity for our neighbors right here at home.

On top of monetary donations, we were also able to collect an overflowing barrel of supplies to send through Catholic Charities to Texas to help in their relief efforts. This is
