St Anthony of Padua



Saint of the Week

Saint Anthony of Padua (1195–1231) was a Portuguese Catholic priest and Franciscan friar widely celebrated as the patron saint of lost items and a profound theologian. Renowned for his brilliant preaching and devotion to the poor, he was canonized less than a year after his death.

Quick Facts

- Birthplace: Lisbon, Portugal
- Ministry: Traveled extensively through France and Italy; known as the "Evangelical Doctor" for his mastery of Scripture.
- Patronage: Lost items, the poor, travelers, and the elderly.
- Feast Day: June 13.

Core Legacy

Born Fernando Martins de Bulhões, he initially joined the Augustinian order but transferred to the Franciscans after being inspired by early Franciscan martyrs. Anthony was a powerful orator capable of captivating massive crowds, famously using his deep knowledge of theology to defend the faith and assist the marginalized. He died in Padua, Italy, at the age of 36. Due to his writings and spiritual impact, he was formally declared a Doctor of the Church in 1946. He is traditionally depicted holding the Child Jesus, a Bible, or a lily.

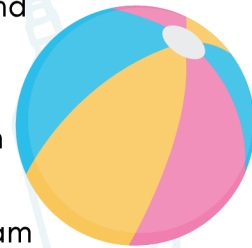
